Easy Peasy Slippah

Join us on November 3rd, via ZOOM, as Lei Batty will show us how to sew our own house slipper (slippah). We have been assured that sewing this slippah is fast and super, super easy.



Our instructor, Lei Batty, grew up in Kailua, Oahu, and is a 1973 Kailua High School graduate. She worked at Kaiser Permanente and retired after 25 years. She then went to work in their family business, American Tire Company, where she did everything from HR, Safety, AP, Sales, etc. In 2017 she retired and moved from her 3-bedroom Kaneohe home to a 2-bedroom condominium in Kaka’ako. With her enormous collection of fabrics and sewing/craft supplies, Lei’s husband suggested she open a store near their new home. Lei now operates DeStash Hawaii where she sells new and vintage fabrics, lace, notions, patterns, and vintage Hawaiian Muumuus and other Hawaiian wear from her beautifully curated closet. In order to complete a pair - you will need: 1/2 yd “Soft and Stable” foam; 1 yd feather-light “HEATnBOND”; 1/2 yd heavy material for the bottom of slippah; 1/2 yd fabric for the top of the slippah; and a 100# machine sewing needle.
